KLES' International School was established on 15th June 2004 and operates under the recognition of the State Government (dated 24th May 2002) and affiliation from the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE Affiliation Number: 830229, School Code: 45210). The school has successfully graduated ten batches of Class X students and seven batches of Class XII students. Currently, the institution serves a diverse student body across all grades from Classes 1 -12 supported by a dedicated team of 84 teaching , 05 non-teaching staff and 45 help staff committed to providing quality education.

The Scholars' Badge Ceremony on 9th July 2025 celebrated academic accomplishments of students from Classes III to X, followed by the Investiture Ceremony on 10th July 2025 formally inducting the student council for 2025-26. A comprehensive CCE Finland Global Accreditation Webinar was conducted on 25th July 2025, featuring eminent speakers including Dr. Madhura Phadke, Principal of A. Naik School Powai, and other distinguished educators from across Asia.

**Newly Introduced Courses and Programs:** The school launched two flagship batches for competitive exam preparation: the Pinnacle Batch for advanced preparation of KCET/NEET/CBSE boards and the Super 20 Batch offering focused mentorship for national ranks in JEE (Main+Advanced) and NEET, with an orientation session conducted by Principal Mrs. Dipti Ingley and Mr. Rahul Mandal on 13th October 2025. Exclusive Masterclasses were initiated for Class 10 students across CBSE, ICSE, and State Board streams, featuring expert-led concept revision sessions, intensive board exam preparation, smart strategies, and doubt-solving support.
