Annual Report 2024

We are pleased to present the Annual Report of KLES' International School, Belagavi, for the year 2024. Since its inception in 2004 and subsequent CBSE affiliation in 2006, the school has evolved into a prestigious institution. With a current student strength of 1,680, supported by 84 dedicated educators, the school continues to thrive in its mission of providing quality education from Grades I to XII.

The school excels in a wide range of academic, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities. It fosters global collaboration through international exchange programs with The Rubekamp School, Bremen, and Friends School, Pennsylvania, and is a proud member of the PASCH network, a global initiative supported by the German Government.

In line with its holistic approach, the school partners with reputed organizations like Shiamak Davar's troupe for dance, TENVIC (Anil Kumble's venture) for sports training, and Furtados School of Music for music education. These collaborations have contributed to the school's distinctive reputation in academics, sports, and culture.

School Strength and Staffing

The student strength for the academic year 2024-25 stands at 1,680 students, including 906 boys and 774 girls across all grades. The teaching staff comprises 84 educators (10 male, 74 female), along with 2 technical staff, 8 clerical staff, and 45 menial staff, totaling 134 employees. The school continues to focus on providing a supportive and enriching environment for both students and staff.

Academic Achievements

The academic year 2023-24 saw impressive results, with 100% pass rate for Grade 10 students (184/184) and a 90.19% pass rate for Grade 12 Science students (46/51). The overall pass percentage for the academic year stood at 97.87% (230/235), demonstrating the school's commitment to academic excellence.

Special Achievements

Several students garnered accolades in various competitions, showcasing exceptional talent in academics, sports, and extracurricular activities:

- Master Avnish Mulani (Grade 3) won multiple trophies in Abacus competitions and secured 1st place in Sanskrit Shloka recitation.
